3.	Does your planning process include ways to make improvements based upon data? How is this done? (helps us respond to standard 3.B.3)
4.	The core theme indicators may not fully measure achievement of the core theme objectives. What other data exists or needs to be collected that supports achievement of your core theme's objectives? (helps us respond to standard 3.B.3)
